

## **Leverett House Prelaw Calendar 2005 - 2006**

Below is a calendar of: (1) important deadlines for prelaw students applying to law school this academic year (2005-2006) and (2) events relevant to all students interested in applying to law school this year or in future years. **Items of particular importance for students applying this year are italicized.** Please note that some events including the Leverett House Prelaw Events (indicated as such by the heading "Leverett House") are subject to change and are thus noted with an asterisk (\*).

### ***August 30, 2005 (Tues): Regular Registration Deadline for the October LSAT***

If you are planning to take the October LSAT, register by August 30<sup>th</sup>. Late registration is available for an additional fee. See [www.lsac.org](http://www.lsac.org) for further details.

***February 4, 2006 (Sat): The February LSAT***

**[Regular Registration Deadline: Jan. 3, 2006 – Late Registration by Jan 13, 2006]**

In general, if you take the February LSAT, you cannot apply to law school until the following academic year (2006-2007).

***June 12, 2006 (Mon): The June LSAT***

If you take the June LSAT, you will have a good idea about where you should apply in the Fall. While alumni/ae may find the June LSAT an optimal time to take the test, most current students find that the June test is not convenient; Harvard College students are usually spending the month of May preparing and taking final exams and cannot find enough time to focus on LSAT preparation.
